

Upon the group's arrival, a lifeguard will meet with the group's supervisor and then with the entire group to explain our rules. I have included a copy of our general beach rules for your information, but there will be others that need to be addressed by the lifeguards. **Adult chaperones are required for youth groups (Children under 12), 1 adult per 5 child ratio is our standard.**

BEACH AND WATER REGULATIONS

1. Bathing hours – 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. weekdays and weekends. No swimming when guards are not on duty.
2. No glass containers are allowed in beach area.
3. No food or drink is allowed near the water of the beach area.
4. No gas or charcoal grills will be allowed in the beach area
5. No alcohol or tobacco of any kind is permitted.
6. **No water flotation devices, swim suits with flotation aids, or diving equipment of any kind permitted. (No water wings, life vests, etc...)**
7. No activity will be allowed that jeopardizes the safety or well being of beach patrons.
8. Shower before entering the pool and after use of toilet facilities.
9. Non-swimmers are restricted to the area so designated. Children 5 years or younger **must** be supervised by an adult.
10. Patrons of the beach are to speak to the lifeguards only in the case of an emergency, and are in no way permitted to interfere with the execution of the guard's duties.
11. Lifeguards may clear the area at any time in case of an emergency. Lifeguards may also clear the area for an emergency drill or safety check.
12. In the event of a storm or other adverse weather conditions, the beach will be closed by the person in charge.
13. Any person exhibiting a health condition or communicable disease which could be detrimental to the well being of themselves or others will be removed from the area at the discretion of the head guard, assistant head guard and the Recreation Supervisor. This includes wounds, sunburn, infections, illness or exhaustion.
14. Intoxicated persons will not be allowed to enter or to remain in the beach area.
15. Patrons shall obey the lifeguards at all times.
16. No animals allowed on the beach area.
17. Patrons must wear proper swimming attire (a swimming suit). Long pants and wet suits are not acceptable. Children 3 and under or non-toilet-trained children **must** wear swim diapers.
18. Metal Detectors will not be allowed inside swimming area
19. No baths will be allowed in the beach area.
20. Hanging on buoys or buoy lines is prohibited.
21. No running dives. Diving permitted from the diving board only.
