

**ORDINANCE 07-01-07**

In the Matter of an Ordinance Approving the Adoption of the Village's Comprehensive Plan and Creating Chapter 34 of the Village's Code of Ordinances.

Pursuant to the provisions of Ch. 66.1001 and Ch. 60.22(3)Wis. Stats., the Village of Slinger Board, Washington County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Having completed the *Village of Slinger Comprehensive Plan*, in accordance with the requirements stipulated in Wisconsin's Smart Growth Law, 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, and defined in Ch. 66.1001 Wis. Stats., and as recommended for adoption by the Village Plan Commission on May 16, 2007, and posted in accordance with Class I Public Notice requirements, the Village of Slinger Board hereby adopts the *Village of Slinger Comprehensive Plan* as the guide for future land use and development decisions in the Village. Specifically, this plan will be used as a guide in Local Subdivision Regulation under s. 236.45, Village Zoning Ordinances under s. 60.62, and Official Mapping.

**BACKGROUND.** On March 30, 2005 the Village of Slinger Plan Commission set a public hearing date for the *Village of Slinger Comprehensive Plan* requesting a final staff review and the required distribution of the plan, in accordance with 1999 Wisconsin Act 9.

Copies of the recommended plan were forwarded to the neighboring communities, Southeast Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Wisconsin Department of Transportation, local school district, Washington County, and the Wisconsin Land Council c/o Wisconsin Department of Administration. Written comments from these agencies and governments were requested by May 18, 2005. Copies of the recommended plan were displayed at the Village Hall and at the Slinger Public Library for 30 days prior to the Public Hearing. The Plan Report was also posted on the Village's Website.

A public hearing was held by the Planning Commission on June 1, 2005. The Planning Commission held additional special meetings to refine the plan recommendations during 2005 and 2006. After completing all refinements at their meeting on May 16, 2007 the Commission recommended that the Village Board adopt the plan.

The Village Board also held a public hearing on July 2, 2007 in conjunction with the adoption of this ordinance.

**AUTHORITY.** This ordinance is enacted pursuant to power granted by virtue of present Wisconsin Statutes, including Section 66.1001(4)(c).

**DEFINITION.** Comprehensive Plan is a plan for development that recognizes the physical, economic, social, political, aesthetic, and related factors of the community. As required by the Wisconsin Smart Growth Legislation, the Comprehensive Plan addresses nine (9) required plan elements: Issues & Opportunities, Housing, Transportation, Agricultural Natural & Cultural Resources, Economic Development, Land Use, Intergovernmental Coordination and Implementation. The Comprehensive Plan also incorporates the Village's Park and Open Space Plan and the recommendations contained therein.

**AMENDMENTS.** The Village of Slinger Planning Commission shall review and recommend all subsequent amendments of the plan to the Village Board for their action. All amendments shall require a public hearing and Class I Public Notice. Copies of the recommended and approved changes shall be mailed to all neighboring units of government and affected agencies, in accordance with the Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.1001 (4)(b) requirements for recommendation of the original plan.

ANNUAL REVIEW. The Planning Commission shall conduct an annual review of the Comprehensive Plan to determine if any substantive amendments are necessary. The annual review shall occur on a 12-month basis from the initial adoption date, and the Commission shall report its findings to the Village Board.

TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS. Minor revisions may be made to the Comprehensive Plan Report text or maps as needed to correct technical errors. Such revisions shall be reviewed and recommended by the Planning Commission and reported to the Village Board and a record thereof kept by the Village Clerk. Such technical corrections are not considered an amendment to the plan as described above.


EFFECT. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication.
