For the meeting of the Slinger Board of Appeals to be held at the Slinger Municipal Building 300 Slinger Road, Slinger, Wisconsin, on Wednesday, February 1, 2012 at 5:30 p.m.

II. Public Hearing:

- A. Petition for Appeal: Larry Wagner and Edward Shanley d/b/a DMT Workholding, are requesting two variances to allow construction of an addition along the entire rear of their building located at 210 Slinger Road. The building is setback 6.8 ft. from the lots south property line, which makes the existing building a nonconforming structure relative to the required minimum setback of 20 ft. for a side yard. Variance No. 1 is required to allow any enlargement of a nonconforming structure in accord with section 8.06 of the zoning ordinance. Variance No. 2 is required related to the specific requirement in the M-1 district for a 20 ft. side yard setback. The proposed addition would be setback 6.2 ft. to 6.8 ft. from the south lot line requiring a variance of 13.8 ft. to 13.2 ft. against the 20 ft. minimum setback requirement.
