Opportunity:

Village of Slinger, WI (pop. 6,500) Slinger is one of the fastest growing communities in Washington County, and is conveniently located near I41 and STH60. The Village has participated in a joint municipal contract with two other communities to obtain inspection services. Due to the strong pace of development, the Village is seeking a full-time Building Inspector to perform inspection and inspection-related administrative services. This position is seen as a strong component in the Village's efforts to promote public safety and economic development. The Village's current contract will continue until the end of 2023 but the intention is to hire an in-house replacement 2-3 months before this to ensure a smooth transition.

The candidate selected will be expected to perform a variety of tasks including, but not limited to, inspection and administrative work regarding properties and buildings to ensure compliance with Local ordinances and State and Federal codes relative to construction, land and building use, and land development in the Village of Slinger. This position will work closely with the Village Planner/Zoning Administrator to manage code compliance and propose code updates or improvements as needed. The position is supported by a part-time Inspection and Zoning Administrative Assistant.

Minimum Requirements:

The Village desires candidates to have obtained UDC Certification in Building, HVAC, Plumbing and Electrical and have at least five (5) years of progressively responsible skilled construction or construction management experience, or a similar combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities. Commercial Building, Electrical, and Plumbing certifications are highly preferred. Knowledge of State and National fire codes would also be beneficial.

Compensation & Benefits:

The Building Inspection is an exempt, non-represented position. Salary range is from \$65,000-\$80,000, dependent on qualifications. The Village participates in the State of Wisconsin Group Health Insurance Program (GHIP), Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS), Wisconsin Deferred Compensation (WDC), Delta Dental, Flexible Spending (FSA) and Long Term Disability Insurance. Employees also receive a personal day, paid holidays, sick pay and paid vacation.
