

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
MEETING REGARDING THE CREATION OF
REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 2

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Sections 66.1333, the Redevelopment Authority of the Village of Slinger will hold a public hearing at the following time and place:

The purpose of this hearing shall be to assist the Redevelopment Authority in making a determination whether the proposed Redevelopment District No. 2 Project Plan is feasible and is in conformity with the general plan of the Village, and in submitting a report concerning this plan to the Slinger Village Board. The project area for the Redevelopment District No. 2 Project Plan is generally described as a roughly 34-acre area in downtown Slinger consisting of properties east and west of Kettle Moraine Drive generally bounded by Tennes Drive on the north and Storck Street on the south as shown on the map below.

All interested parties will be afforded a full opportunity to express their views respecting the proposed plan at this public hearing. Any owner of property included within the boundaries of the redevelopment plan and objecting to such plan shall be required to state his or her objections and reasons therefore, in writing, and file the same with the Redevelopment Authority either prior to, at the time of the public hearing, or within fifteen (15) days thereafter. Such owner must state their mailing address and sign their name to these reasons. The filing of such objections in writing is a condition to the commencement of an action to contest the right of a redevelopment authority to condemn the property under Wisconsin Statutes Section 32.06(5).
